This series features, Emily a dynamic, six year old host, who leads children and adults alike through a new era of discovery utilizing her unique perspective. Whether learning about sushi, snowboarding or the space shuttle each episode looks at the world through Emily's eyes allowing children to connect with this age-appropriate role model who is essentially just like them. Using this natural, unscripted format, Emily investigates the world through her own candid comments and questions engaging everyone she meets. The result is an extraordinary show that entertains and teaches.

Each 1/2 hour episode bundles 5 - 6 minute segments.

## Episode #1 – Getting Creative Pt I

- 1) **This is Emily Yeung beading;** Emily Yeung visits a local beading store and chooses from hundreds of colourful beads to make a necklace. She even finds a unique cat bead.
- 2) **This is Emily Yeung making origami;** Emily Yeung joins an origami artist to learn how to fold paper into different shapes. Emily makes a dolphin and a wearable paper helmet!
- 3) **This is Emily Yeung making animal balloons;** Emily Yeung joins a balloon artist to learn how to twist balloons into different animal shapes. Emily rides a big balloon motorcycle.
- 4) **This is Emily Yeung making a clay dolphin;** Emily Yeung visits a clay studio to make a dolphin plate - then she adds a shark, a mermaid and an octopus grabbing the mermaid's foot!
- 5) **This is Emily Yeung making a collage;** Emily Yeung joins a collage artist to learn how to use different materials to make a really cool collage - of her favourite animal species - cats!

## Episode #2 – Getting Creative Pt II

- 1) **This is Emily Yeung making a stuffed animal;** Join Emily Yeung as she makes a new stuffed animal friend. Emily makes a stuffed zebra that she names and chooses a dress for.
- 2) **This is Emily Yeung knitting;** Emily Yeung meets a young knitting enthusiast who teaches her how to make a bean bag toy using knitting needles, wool, and a simple pattern.
- 3) **This is Emily Yeung building a sand sculpture;** Emily Yeung teams up with a world champion sand sculptor to make a giant sand dolphin...that she can actually ride!
- 4) **This is Emily Yeung making a sun catcher;** Emily sketches a picture of a flower and places it under a small pane of glass. She then glues glass nuggets in the shape of her sketch to make her very own unique sun catcher design!
- 5) **This is Emily Yeung making a wind chime;** Emily Yeung loves the sounds wind chimes make - especially on really windy days! Emily and a local artist decide to make a unique wind chime out of things you can find in your kitchen like forks, knives and spoons...wait a minute, what are you going to eat dinner with?

## Episode #3 - All Sorts of Animals

- 1) **This is Emily Yeung learning about snakes;** Emily gets up close and personal with her favourite slithery friends when she visits the zoo to meet several different types of snakes...including giant boa constrictors!
- 2) **This is Emily Yeung taking care of kittens;** Emily Yeung joins a fellow cat enthusiast to help her take care of some new kittens. Emily learns how to properly feed and play with her new feline friends before making them a bed.
- 3) **This is Emily Yeung learning about camels;** One hump or two? Emily helps feed and groom a camel before saddling her up to go for a camel ride!
- 4) **This is Emily Yeung swimming with dolphins;** Emily Yeung visits a marine centre to learn about one of her favourite ocean mammals - dolphins! Emily learns how they use sounds to find their food and why their skin feels like rubber.
- 5) **This is Emily Yeung snorkeling;** Emily Yeung is snorkeling with sharks! She learns about the different fish that live in the ocean. Emily also meets manta rays and a parrot fish.

## Episode #4 - Great Canadian Wonders

- 1) **This is Emily Yeung at an ice hotel;** Emily Yeung visits a hotel made completely of ice! She learns how to sculpt an ice dolphin, visits an ice chapel, and even tries out an ice bed!
- 2) **This is Emily Yeung touring Quebec City;** Bonjour mes amis! Emily Yeung has been invited to tour Quebec City. Emily tours the historic Chateau Frontenac before skating on an outdoor rink during a snowfall.
- 3) **This is Emily Yeung at an amusement park;** Emily Yeung visits Ontario Place for a little fun in the sun. Emily climbs through a giant jungle gym then hits the bumper boats. Emily ends her day with a fast ride down a waterslide.
- 4) **This is Emily Yeung visiting a hot spring;** Emily Yeung explores a natural hot spring in Banff Alberta. She learns how hot water from within the Earth bubbles up to the surface and stays warm even on cold winter days. Emily also meets some unlikely animals that like to live in the hot springs.
- 5) **This is Emily Yeung exploring the Rocky Mountains;** Emily Yeung is exploring the Rockies! She learns about how these mountains came to be and meets some of the animals that like to live around them - a skunk, a porcupine and even a wolf.

## Episode #5 - Fit and Fun

1) **This is Emily Yeung snowboarding;** Watch Emily Yeung hit the ski slopes for her first lesson in snowboarding. Emily learns how to use both her feet to control the direction of the board as she zips down the hill. Watch out Emily, wipe out!

2) **This is Emily Yeung cross country skiing;** Emily Yeung loves winter activities. Working with a ski instructor, Emily learns how to cross country ski down a beautiful wooded path and even has a chance to practice her birdcalls, tweet tweet!

3) **This is Emily Yeung playing basketball;** Emily Yeung is forming her own basketball team: "The Mermaids" to challenge a player from the Raptors to a game of one on one. Emily learns how to pass the ball, dribble and slam-dunk.

4) **This is Emily Yeung playing road hockey;** Game on! Emily Yeung joins two time Olympic hockey gold medalist Hayley Wickenheiser for a one on one road hockey lesson. Emily learns how to pass, shoot and do slap shots.

5) **This is Emily Yeung playing soccer;** Goal! Emily Yeung meets a member of the Canadian Women's National Soccer Team and learns the basics of playing soccer. Emily puts her newfound knowledge to good use when she joins in a game.

## Episode #6 - Great Times in all Kinds of Weather

1) **This is Emily Yeung making a snowman;** Emily Yeung puts on her winter jacket because she's heading outside to build a snowman! Emily learns how to roll bigger and bigger balls out of snow and how to stack them on top of each other.

2) **This is Emily Yeung exploring a castle;** Emily Yeung is on the hunt for...Easter eggs! Emily visits historic Casa Loma and searches its many secret passageways looking for Easter eggs.

3) **This is Emily Yeung riding a bike;** Emily Yeung is racing the fastest woman cyclist on the planet! Emily chooses a bike and learns about bike safety before hitting the track.

4) **This is Emily Yeung on a rainy day;** It's raining...it's pouring and Emily Yeung finds it boring. What's a girl to do on a rainy day? Why not make paper airplanes and race them before heading outside to jump in some big puddles?

5) **This is Emily Yeung skipping rope;** Emily Yeung joins a champion skipping team and learns how they combine gymnastics with skipping (two of Emily's favourite things).

## Episode #7 - Creatures, Creations, and Conservation

1) **This is Emily Yeung exploring the forest;** Who knew there were so many cool things living under a log? Emily Yeung is exploring the forest floor with a local naturalist.

2) **This is Emily Yeung learning about an eco-house;** Emily Yeung visits an eco-house and learns how they use the wind and the sun to power their home. Emily tours the garden before heading inside to learn some easy environmental tricks.

3) **This is Emily Yeung doing science experiments;** Emily Yeung has become a mad scientist in the kitchen! She's making volcano like eruptions and creating mucky sludge! Now who's going to clean all this mess up?

4) **This is Emily Yeung learning about worms;** Emily Yeung visits a unique composting facility that uses 3,000,000 worms to make fertilizer. Emily helps sort the worm's food, before learning how worm poo is one of a plant's favourite foods!

5) **This is Emily Yeung planting a tree;** Emily Yeung learns how people are helping the environment by planting baby trees. Emily explores a restored wetland before learning what conditions trees need to grow and how to find the perfect spot to plant her sapling.

## Episode #8 - A Few of My Favourite Things

1) **This is Emily Yeung ice fishing;** Emily Yeung is going fishing... in the winter! Emily joins an ice fishing enthusiast and together, they cut a hole in the ice and sip hot chocolate as they wait patiently for any fish to bite. Here, fishy fishy...brrr!

2) **This is Emily Yeung building a tree house;** Emily Yeung joins Mike Holmes to build a tree house. Emily helps make sure the planks are level, measures the wood and builds a sun design out of leftover wood scraps for the front door of the tree house.

3) **This is Emily Yeung dressing up;** Emily Yeung works with a costume specialist to create her very own one of a kind princess dress. Emily starts with a drawing of her dress, then chooses fabric and accessories to bring her design to life.

4) **This is Emily Yeung learning about fireworks;** Boom! Emily Yeung has been invited to watch one of the most spectacular fireworks spectacles on Earth. Emily heads down to Disney World, the largest buyer of fireworks in the world, to learn how they create their explosive fireworks shows.

5) **This is Emily Yeung learning about rabbits;** Did you know people make clothes and scarves out of rabbit fur? Neither did Emily Yeung until she met with a rabbit farmer who shows her how to brush cute angora rabbits and spin their fur into yarn.

## Episode #9 - A Day in My Life

1) **This is Emily Yeung at the Humane Society;** Emily Yeung visits a Humane Society and learns what the Humane Society does for the community. Emily meets several different animals that live at the Humane Society.

2) **This is Emily Yeung with the paramedics;** Emily Yeung learns how and when to call 911 when she visits the paramedics. Emily practices a 911 call before exploring an ambulance and learning about how all its equipment is used to help people.

3) **This is Emily Yeung at the post office;** Neither hail, nor sleet, nor snow will stop Emily Yeung from learning how to deliver the mail. Emily mails a letter to her grandma and follows it as it travels to grandma's house.

4) **This is Emily Yeung training to be an astronaut;** Emily Yeung is training to be an astronaut at NASA. Emily joins real life astronaut Cady Coleman and learns what it takes to become a space explorer.

5) **This is Emily Yeung learning about water safety;** Emily Yeung joins the marine police department and learns how they rescue people from the water. Emily learns she should always find an adult if she hears someone calling for help and watches as the police practice a helicopter rescue!

## Episode #10 - Let's Get Cookin'

- 1) **This is Emily Yeung making an upside down pineapple cake;** Emily Yeung joins a cake-maker to learn how to make a cake with her favourite fruit! She also solves the mystery of why it is called upside down when you eat it right side up!
- 2) **This is Emily Yeung making juice;** Emily Yeung can't wait to use the big juicing machine when she visits a local juice restaurant. Emily makes a tasty healthy drink treat!
- 3) **This is Emily Yeung making strawberry jam;** There are two things Emily Yeung loves, strawberries and strawberries in ice cream. Emily goes strawberry picking AND she makes jam.
- 4) **This is Emily Yeung baking bread;** Emily Yeung visits a Pioneer Village and learns how people baked bread in the past. Emily mixes all the ingredients, kneads the dough and helps put the bread in an old fashioned stove.
- 5) **This is Emily Yeung making muffins;** Emily Yeung joins a baker to make one of her favourite breakfast treats...muffins!

## Episode #11 - Sharing Multicultural Traditions

- 1) **This is Emily Yeung learning karate;** Watch Emily Yeung hit the karate mat and take no prisoners. Emily earns her white belt as she learns to throw, kick, and punch. Back off!
- 2) **This is Emily Yeung making sushi;** Get your chopsticks ready, because Emily Yeung is visiting a Japanese restaurant to learn how to make sushi.
- 3) **This is Emily Yeung making bubble tea;** Emily Yeung joins a creative chef at Monsoon Restaurant and learns how to turn bubble tea and fruit into a delicious and colourful dessert.
- 4) **This is Emily Yeung learning an African dance;** Emily Yeung learns about African dancing when she joins an African dance troupe. Emily Yeung learns how to make music with her body.
- 5) **This is Emily Yeung making a medicine wheel;** Emily Yeung learns about the meaning of medicine wheels when she joins a First Nations craft person to make her own.

## Episode #12 - At the Farm

- 1) **This is Emily Yeung taking care of horses;** Emily Yeung visits a stable and learns how horses are fed and cared for during the winter. Emily even goes for a special winter ride.
- 2) **This is Emily Yeung on a tractor;** Emily Yeung learns how farmers use big machines to make large jobs easier. Emily learns how to operate a tractor before planting some seeds.
- 3) **This is Emily Yeung learning about chickens;** Emily Yeung visits an organic farm to help them collect chicken eggs. Emily also learns what chickens eat and where they sleep in their coops.
- 4) **This is Emily Yeung becoming a cowgirl;** Yee haw! Emily Yeung is putting on her cowgirl hat to visit a horse ranch in Alberta. Emily rides a horse and learns what cowgirls do!
- 5) **This is Emily Yeung making goat cheese;** Emily Yeung combines two of her favourite things: animals and eating when she visits a farm to make goat cheese. Emily helps milk a goat and learns how to separate the curds and whey.

## Episode #13 - Putting on a Show

- 1) **This is Emily Yeung putting on a puppet show;** Emily Yeung is putting on a puppet show and you're invited. Emily works with a professional ventriloquist to learn how to 'throw' her voice.
- 2) **This is Emily Yeung ballet dancing;** Emily Yeung meets Canada's premiere ballerina Karen Kain for a ballet dancing session. Emily learns what the names are for the ballet dance moves she likes to do before she performs Snow White.
- 3) **This is Emily Yeung with Cirque du Soleil;** Emily Yeung is heading under the big top to experience the magical world of Cirque du Soleil. Emily learns how to perform special tricks.
- 4) **This is Emily Yeung with the Blue Man Group;** Emily Yeung joins the Blue Man Group and learns about who they are and how they create their amazing performances. Emily even gets to get painted blue and joins them on stage for a rehearsal.
- 5) **This is Emily Yeung making a mask;** Emily Yeung loves making faces...especially ones out of clay! Emily tours an art exhibit for ideas before sitting down with an artist friend to make her very own horse mask.

## Holiday Special (A Bonus Gift when you purchase the series)

**This is Emily Yeung celebrating the holidays;** Emily Yeung joins a local gospel caroling group and sings some carols in the neighbourhood. At each neighbour she visits, Emily is invited in to see how they practice their cultural festivities. After the visits, Emily goes home to decorate her Christmas tree and make Christmas cookies. That night all her new friends join her for a party where they sample the foods each family made and sing Deck The Halls! In addition to Christmas, Emily celebrates:

**Chanukah;** Emily Yeung helps make latkes and plays the dreidel game before helping light the menorah candles.

**Eid;** Emily Yeung learns that Eid is a Muslim celebration of family and sharing. She makes a special envelope with a donation to her favourite charity, makes paper lanterns to decorate the house, and helps prepare savai, a traditional dessert.

**Kwanzaa;** Emily Yeung joins a family celebrating the harvest festival of Kwanzaa. She helps lay out a cloth on which she places a ceremonial mat and a candle-holder with seven candles. Emily learns about the three colours of Kwanzaa and their meanings. Then she helps pour a libation into the Unity Cup for the ancestors. Finally, she helps make cornbread, a traditional Kwanzaa harvest food.

NOTE: This episode runs a full half hour and is not made up of selectable segments.
